

USE M.S.A. TO SEND ALIENS OUT OF CANADA

Capt. C. G. Jeakins Says Troopships Could Be Utilized for
Deporting Them.

"Public sentiment is behind the G.W.V.A. and the returned men on the alien question," stated Capt. C. E. Jeakins, of Brantford, Provincial president of the G.W.V.A., to The Star.

Captain Jeakins favors the use of the M.S.A. machinery in dealing with the alien problem. The idea of local tribunals, recently advanced by the Dominion Government, is heartily endorsed by the War Veterans' Provincial president.

Capt. Jeakins did not believe that there was any shortage of ships to interfere with deporting alien enemies. The men are coming home by the thousand from overseas, he pointed out, and these ships could be utilized to take the aliens back. There were, however, he admitted, some complications with regard to landing them in their own countries at the present time.
