

GERMAN FORCED TO GO

Penticton Vigilance League Refuses
to Allow Enemy Alien to Stay.

PENTICTON, B. C., March 8.—
Short shift was made here of the re-
turn to town of one Louis Degere,
believed to be a German sympathizer,
by the Vigilance League, headed by
President Clark.

The protection of the police was
extended for 24 hours until the arrival
of the Oroville stage. Before being
allowed to enter the departing car,
however, Degere was obliged to
kneel down and kiss the flag and to
listen to a speech on the dirty work of
the enemy.
