The demands of the veterars were put forward by a number of commales, some of whom threatened vigorous action on the part of the returned men if this menace to the life of the province, as it was pit, was not removed. It was pointed out that there were 24,000 aliens in Winniper yet only 3 000 had appeared before the board.
