

MR. MACKIE UPHELD BY WINNIPEG CLERK

Affidavit Gives Details of De- portation Exemption.

WINNIPEG, May 8.—S. O. Char-ambula, of Winnipeg, is the man who told H. A. Mackie, M.P., East Edmonton, that a politician employ-
ed by the Manitoba Government is-
sued deportation exemption cards.

Charambula today made an affi-
davit to the effect that he acted as
a clerk on a committee appointed
by virtue of an order-in-council
passed by the Provincial Govern-
ment to compel foreigners to appear
and show "cause why they should
not be deported."

A questionnaire was presented to
the applicant, the affidavit states,
and he was told that if he did not
answer the questions and secure an
exemption certificate he would no
longer be able to get a job, and the
Manitoba Government would cause
his deportation; his property would
be confiscated, leaving him only
\$75 with which to leave the country.
