

DANISH BOY WILL KNOW HIS FATE NEXT MONDAY

Arrives in City With Foster Parents
Who Are to Be Deported to
Der Faderland.

The fate of Ebbie Hansen, a 12-year-old boy whom the Children's Aid Society of Winnipeg is seeking to recover from his German foster parents, will be decided on Monday.

Mr. Max Grossman, for the foster parents, stated in chambers that they arrived in the city this morning with the boy from the internment camp at Vernon, and were being held in surveillance by the internment officer here. He asked for an adjournment to consult them.

The foster parents are Mr. and Mrs. Cargen, and as they have become attached to the boy do not wish to part with him. Their deportation to German has been ordered, however, and the Children's Aid Society is making application for the recovery of the boy, who is of Danish parentage, because they do not want him brought up as a German.
