## GERMAN PRISONERS ARE SENT HOME FROM VERNON

After Five Years in Interment Camp, Alien Enemies Are Deported—Only Ninety Remain.

VERNON, B. C., June 3.—One hundred and sixty-three German prisoners who have been confined to the internment camp here for nearly five years left yesterday for England in charge of an officer and about 30 guards. It is presumed that from England they will be deported to Germany. This leaves only about ninety prisoners, most of whom are married, in the Varnon camp, and it is rumored that these will be sent away shortly and the camp closed in

about a month.
