

TO HEAR HABEAS CORPUS IN DEPORTATION CASE THURSDAY

Habeas corpus proceedings in an attempt to quash the deportation order made by the special board of inquiry against Oscar Schoppelrei, one of the four men of foreign birth held by the federal authorities under the immigration act, was opened this morning before Chief Justice Mathers. The order was made returnable Thursday and will be argued before the chief justice by Marcus Hyman.

The case of Solomon Pearl Almazoff will come up at the same time. Hyman is attempting to obtain bail for Almazoff and to obtain a similar ruling affecting Sam Blumenberg and Matthew Charitinoff, the remaining men held at immigration hall.
