

ALIEN ENEMIES TRY TO GET OUT OF CANADA

Austrians Foiled in Attempt to Escape on Ship

MONTREAL, Aug. 16.—What is believed to be a plot to enable Bukovinian Austrians to leave Canada, where they are still considered alien enemies, until the peace treaty is officially ratified by the Dominion government, was frustrated early yesterday morning by local police.

Just before the Roumanian ship *Jiul* was to sail from Montreal, the police arrived and made the captain parade his crew before them. Three of the men were found to be persons who were about to get a passage to Roumania, and who were armed with Roumanian passports. The three were arrested and reported to be still held by the authorities.
