

IMMIGRANTS MUST HAVE \$250 BEFORE THEY ENTER CANADA

That is if They are Merchants,
Artisans or
Laborers

Montreal, Jan. 13.—The attention of shipping companies has been called to order-in-council No. P. C.-2499, which lays an embargo on the entrance into Canada for the time being of immigrants who are merchants, artisans or laborers, skilled or unskilled, unless they possess a monetary qualification of \$250, as well as transportation to their destination. This restriction operates from December 31 last, and will remain in force until March 31 next, unless otherwise ordered.
