Undesirable Aliens' Attempt to Slip Past Immigration Officials

STEAMSHIP CO'S WARNED

(Staff Correspondence of The Gibbe) Ottawa, Sept. 5.—So many European immigrants, mainly **Poles** and Russian Jews, have been attempting to enter **Canada** in contravention of the regulations, that the Department of Immigration has sent peremptory cables to the steamship companies, warning them against bringing any more of this class of immigrants.

Immigrants from Europe are not barred where relatives send them prepaid tickets, or if they come from their homes on a continuous jourey. The majority of them, however, have not come direct, and a great number simply intend to use Cannda as a back-door by which to evade the United States restrictive regulations. Most of those who intend to remain in Canada are booked for the big cities.

So many have been turned back of late that the department has warned the steamship lines to conduct examinations on the other side to prevent this wasteful manner of dealing with ineligibles.

Those sent back return at the expense of the steamship companies.
