Between 1914 and 1920, thousands of Ukrainians and other East Europeans were unjustly declared “enemy aliens” and imprisoned during Canada’s first national internment operations.

These victims of prejudice were confined to 24 internment camps and receiving stations, of which six were located in Ontario – at Kapuskasing, Kingston, Niagara Falls, Petawawa, Toronto and Sault St. Marie.
